How to video call





Open WhatsApp on your phone and click 'Calls'.



Press the icon showing a phone with a plus symbol next to it.



Click the magnifying glass icon and type the name of the person you want to call.








Click the symbol that looks like a camera next to their name to start video calling.









How to video call



You can add other people into a video call to turn it into a group chat. During the video call, just click the add participant icon and search for their name to add them.



If you prefer you can begin the call as a group chat by clicking 'new group call' and selecting who you would like to call.
